The founder of the Scout movement in 1907



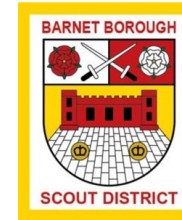
## Backwoods cooking

A gathering of scouts at national or international level



## Mess tent

A large tent for cooking and storage on camp

## Wide game

A game played in a large outdoor space



## Woggle

A device used to hold up your scarf
