Baden-Powell

The founder of the Scout movement in 1907



Backwoods cooking

Cooking without a kitchen, usually over an open fire



Chief Scout

The person who leads Scouting in the UK



District

A collection of local Scout Groups



Flag break

A ceremony held at the start of meetings or events



Fleur-de-lis

The Scout emblem, worn by members all over the world



Forum

A meeting for all members to discuss the programme



Gang show

A stage performance in front of a live audience



Gilwell Park

The site of the UK national headquarters



Jamboree

A gathering of scouts at national or international level



Necker

Another word for a scarf, short for neckerchief



OSM

A system to sign up to events and see your badges



Pioneering

Making a structure from poles and rope



Wide game

A game played in a large outdoor space



Woggle

A device used to hold up your scarf
